### GLOBAL MISSIONS CONFERENCE

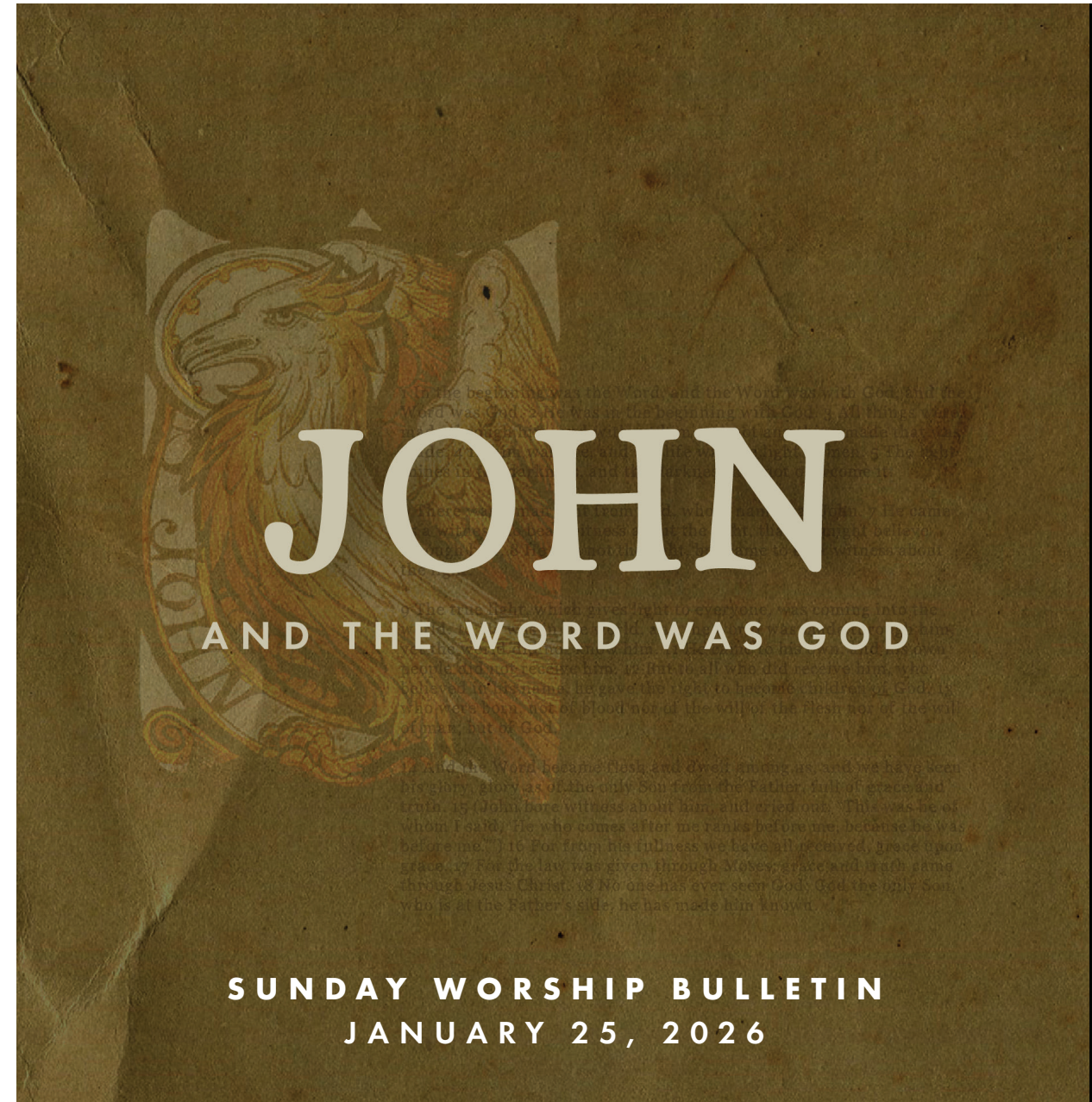
